Prepare Your Unit



Thank you for choosing CHF BC's cabinet and countertop program for your co-op's kitchen and/or bathroom renovations. The following instructions will help to ensure that your renovation goes as smoothly as possible.

Cabinet and countertop installation:

During kitchen renovations the fridge and stove will be pulled away from the wall. The sink will also have to be removed and replaced. The following instructions will help ensure that your possessions remain safe and secure.

- Disconnect and remove any electrical equipment from the countertops.
- Remove all loose items from the cupboards and countertops. Store any fragile items in a safe place.
- Remove valuables (ie. cash and jewelry) for safekeeping.
- Remove all items from the cabinets, drawers and under the sink.
- Remove any dishes from the sink and dishwasher.
- Secure items in your fridge very well to avoid spills (ie. tape milk cartons closed) during removal and replacement.
- Arrange for the freezer to be moved before installation.
- Identify the location of water shut off valve, if not directly under the sink.
- Store pots and pans from the oven drawer in boxes or in cupboard.
- Installers are not qualified to disconnect or reconnect gas appliances. Please make appropriate arrangements with qualified appliance personnel, equipped to perform this service safely.
- For ease of installation, ensure continued access to your kitchen and/or bathroom spaces that are being renovated.

Pets –

- Installation noise and disruption may be disturbing to some pets. Please protect your pet. Place in a cage or better yet, arrange "pet care" for the day!
