#### **Delivering education and support to members**

- Continued raising the bar on co-op governance with Model Rules 2.0
- Led 50 portable workshops for almost 400 members at 40 co-ops
- Welcomed over 350 members from more than 90 co-ops to education conferences and Island education events
- Launched a new scheduled workshop series to better serve our members, including a webinar for co-ops at a distance
- Provided advice, support and chairing services at 91 meetings for almost 50 co-ops
- Answered hundreds of questions from members in every area of co-op governance and management

## Adding value to your membership

- Partnered with TELUS to launch our new Telecom Program to bring HDTV, high speed internet and home phone service to co-op members at unbeatable prices. Get more information at cotel.ca
- Continued to help co-ops with long-term planning, delivering building condition assessments, asset management plans and securing financing for asset renewal
- Helped members achieve huge savings through our popular group buying programs
- Counted more than \$58 million in CHIP account balances, generating more than \$560,000 in bonus interest earnings for member co-ops

## **Speaking up for housing co-ops**

- Led the "You Hold the Key" campaign in BC to protect expiring subsidies for low-income members
- Elected 32 co-op-friendly MPs in BC in the last federal election
- Won a firm commitment from the federal government to extend subsidies for low-income members until March 2018
- Led a discussion to protect housing co-ops on land leased from the City of Vancouver

## Building the community of housing co-ops in BC

- Began construction on the 278-unit Fraserview Housing Co-op through our community land trust
- Awarded three more scholarships through the CHF BC Scholarship Fund
- Sponsored four future co-op leaders to attend YES summer camps
- Launched "Housing Central" to promote unity in the co-op and non-profit housing sectors in BC. We now share offices with the BC Non-Profit Housing Association
- Celebrated our success with you at the Member Appreciation evening in Victoria
