The provincial Civil Resolution Tribunal has assumed jurisdiction over some disputes between housing co-ops and their members. The CRT's goal is to provide easy and inexpensive access to justice. Join us to learn how it might impact your co-op and what you can do to be prepared.

You will be able to:

- become aware of Civil Resolution Tribunal (CRT) Amendment Act
- understand the likely steps in taking a dispute to the CRT
- consider the impact this could have on your housing
- explore ways you can prepare for disputes submitted to the CRT

Workshop facilitators:
