
## 2022 is a **milestone** year for us.

Forty years ago, a group of housing co-ops united, creating a federation to be a resource and voice for B.C.'s housing co-ops. Now we represent almost **15,000 co-op homes**, employ more than **130 staff** and are a leader in the co-op housing movement.

Stronger than ever, we provide our members with the representation and resources they need to thrive. CHF BC is part of a national and international co-operative movement bound together by **principles** that have stood the test of time.

## Moving Forward Together – Working Toward A Shared Vision For A Bright Future.

To support housing co-operatives in being thriving communities, the CHF BC group of social enterprises adopted three strategic goals: **belonging**, **sustainability**, and **growth**.



We welcome the recent federal budget announcement of **\$1.5 billion dollars** specifically targeted **to develop 6,000 more co-op homes** across the country. This is the first new federal co-op housing program in 30 years and we are excited to work with our partners at CHF Canada.

Harnessing the combined purchasing power of 15,000 households to provide **significant savings on quality products and services** that housing co-ops need.

CHIP (Co-operative Housing Interest Pool) program will deliver even more value to members and better returns to CHF BC than to retail customers.

As of June 1, 2022, deposits in the Vancity CHIP account were earning 1.8% interest, more than a full percentage point higher than typical retail accounts.
