The role will be responsible for all aspects of Financial Management, including maintaining data and accuracy using accounting systems, cash management, financial reporting, coordination of the budgeting process, and completing statutory/regulatory compliance/reporting. The successful candidate will not only be an accomplished accountant and proactive with company finances but will also be commercially aware and provide advice on the best path of growth for our business.

The ideal candidate will also be an excellent communicator with outstanding interpersonal and leadership abilities. Your ultimate goal will be to guide the company towards financial sustainability and success.

Key Responsibilities

Primary Responsibilities:

- Develop and consolidate the Corporate Budget for the organization and all its entities
- Prepare monthly financial statements for all entities (Income statement, balance sheet, Trial Balance, Cash flows, etc.)
- Report the financial performance to the Management team by presenting the financial statements at various intervals
- Develop and implement accounting policies, procedures, and systems to ensure company financial information is fairly stated
- Evaluate the effectiveness of existing financial policies/practices and recommend measures for process improvements.
- Monitor debt covenants and identify new borrowing opportunities
- Analyze Cash flow trends and recommend strategic measures for Cash Management
- Recognize patterns in company spending, and revenue, and recommend solutions to any problem areas.

- Prepare financial proposals and a business case study to secure financing for new development projects
- Support the external auditors in completing the year-end audit. This will involve preparing various reports and presenting the audit findings to the Management team.
- Supervise the work of accounting staff to ensure all accounting and financial reporting activities are completed on an accurate and timely basis
- Provide coaching, mentorship, and training to the Finance team
- Develop supportive relationships with colleagues using collaborative, cross-functional, strategic relationships to facilitate the accomplishment of financial objectives.
