Staff announced a new partnership with Telus to provide members with exclusive savings on mobile medical alert devices and invited members to apply for CHF BC's Sustainability Grant for projects with a focus on greening initiatives and reducing the impact of climate change.

CHF Canada Director-at-Large, Anne Davidson, provided an update on CHF Canada's activities and resources in BC and across Canada, including condolences for the passing of past CHF Canada CCHF Canada's Reconciliation Toolkit, Greener Co-op Microgrants, and regional energy coach; the 2022 federal budget, and the lack of progress towards a Urban, Rural and Northern Indigenous Housing Strategy; the new national Aging in Place Exchange Network; and, the CHF Canada AGM is in Halifax from June 16 to 18.
