

CHF BC Scholarship Fund Application Deadline: Friday, March 31, 2023, 4:30 pm

Introduction

The Co-operative Housing Federation of BC (CHF BC) works to support the community of housing co-ops in BC. The purpose of the CHF BC Scholarship Fund is to support the educational goals of co-op members, particularly young co-op members who are already making a contribution to their communities. Our goal is to invest in the future of housing co-ops by supporting the education and development of young co-op and community leaders. Scholarships can be awarded to students graduating from high school and planning to enroll in a college, university, or apprenticeship program; students already enrolled in a college, university, or apprenticeship program; and students returning to school after a break in their education. Scholarships are for undergraduate studies only.

Eligibility

Applicants must:

- ✓ Live in a CHF BC member co-op
- ✓ Plan to attend, or already attend, a Canadian, publicly funded, accredited college, university or government-approved apprenticeship program on a full-time basis in the 2022/2023 academic year
- ✓ Have made a positive contribution to their school, co-op, or community
- ✓ Demonstrate financial need

Scholarship Awards

The maximum award is \$5,000. Scholarship winners will receive \$2,000 in their first year of study and \$1,000 each year thereafter for up to four years of study. Scholarship winners who are already enrolled in a program will receive \$2,000 in their first scholarship year. Scholarships are for undergraduate studies only. **The application deadline is 4:30 p.m. on March 31**, 2023.
