

Housing Transitions Research

A study on the lived experiences of housing transitions in Canada

The research

This study aims to better understand the lived experiences of transitions within the 'housing continuum'. To do this, we will conduct interviews with housing cooperative residents in British Columbia. We are looking to speak with residents who have transitioned into or out of a housing cooperative recently (i.e. in the past five years).

The interviews

Interviews can be conducted in English or French. Each interview will be approximately one hour long. All interviews will be strictly confidential and data will be anonymized.

This study is being conducted by David Wachsmuth and the Urban Politics and Governance (UPGo) research group at McGill University in partnership with the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation. Findings from this research will be released in a public report in 2024.
